



## FREDERICK ASSOCIATION OF SCHOOL SUPPORT EMPLOYEES SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

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The Frederick Association of School Support Employees (FASSE) awards one scholarship each spring to an eligible Frederick County Public Schools (FCPS) high school senior who will attend a university, college, or technical school in the fall.

FASSE will award a \$500.00 scholarship mid May 2023.

### Eligibility

- FCPS high school seniors whose parent/grandparent/guardian is a current FASSE member.

### Criteria for Application Consideration

- Applicant is enrolled with a two or four-year college/university/technical school for the fall of 2023.
- High school seniors must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Application is complete and signed upon submission. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
- Application is received via U.S. mail, FCPS courier, or via email no later than **4:00 pm on Friday, March 31, 2023**. The Scholarship Committee will not consider applications received after this date.

### Timeline

- The Scholarship Committee will review applications that meet the stated criteria and select an awardee the week of April 21.
- The Scholarship Committee will notify awardee of selection in writing by mid-May.

### Application Process

- Applicant must **complete and sign** the application form and submit responses to five (5) questions. **Again, incomplete applications will not be considered.**
- Applicant must provide
  - a copy of an official high school transcript
  - two (2) letters of recommendation from non-family members; one must come from a Frederick County Public Schools staff member
